

RETURNING YOUR VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT

Vote-by-mail (absentee) ballots must be received in the Sarasota County supervisor of elections office no later than 7 p.m. on election night to be counted.

You may return your vote-by-mail ballot by mail or in person. If you return by mail, please mail early to avoid postal delays. The return postage for this election is one Forever Stamp or \$.58.

A voter may return a vote-by-mail ballot in person to the supervisor of elections by placing the return mail envelope containing the marked ballot into a secure drop box located inside each of the three offices of the supervisor of elections (listed below) during normal business hours or at a designated early voting site during early voting.

Pursuant to 101.69 Fla. Stat., for the **November 2 City of Venice and Town of Longboat Key elections**, the supervisor of elections has designated vote-by-mail drop box locations as follows:

All Supervisor of Elections Offices (Vote-by-Mail Drop Box Return)

Friday, Sept 17 – Friday, Oct 22, weekdays (M-F), 8:30 a.m. – 5 p.m.

Sunday, Oct 24 – Monday, Nov 1, daily (including weekends), 8:30 a.m. – 5 p.m.

Tuesday, Nov 2 (election day), 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.

Drop boxes will also be available during early voting for the Nov. 2 City of Venice General Election at the supervisor of elections office in Venice as follows:

There will be no early voting for the Nov. 2 Town of Longboat Key election.
