During this primary election, every registered voter may vote. However, your political party affiliation will affect which candidates are on your ballot. Florida has closed primaries, which means that you must be registered with a political party in order to vote in a party's primary election.

All registered voters, whether affiliated with a political party or not, can vote on issues and nonpartisan candidates, such as for school board and judicial offices, in a primary election.

### UNIVERSAL PRIMARY CONTEST

If all the candidates for an office have the same party affiliation and the winner of the primary election will not face any opposition in the general election, then all registered voters, regardless of party affiliation, can vote for any of the candidates for that office in the primary election. This is known as a universal primary contest.
